### A.2. Short Biography

Carrol Gamble is a Professor of Medical Statistics at the University of Liverpool, an NIHR Senior Investigator and Director of the Liverpool Clinical Trials Centre a clinical trials unit (CTU) registered with the UK Clinical Research Collaboration (UKCRC).

After completing a BSc in Mathematics and Statistics at the University of Liverpool, Carrol undertook a three-year training fellowship in London, completing a PhD in publication bias in meta-analysis as well as gaining expertise in teaching medical statistics and consultancy. After her PhD she continued with interests in meta-analysis and in particular selective reporting with research positions in Oxford and then as a lecturer at the Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine where she became the statistical editor of the Cochrane Infectious Diseases Group.

Opportunities to undertake primary research in clinical trials took Carrol back to the University of Liverpool where she developed a portfolio of research relevant to paediatric clinical trials via the Medicines for Childrens Research Network. Carrol's methodological interests focus on recruitment and retention in clinical trials and consent where there is an urgent need to treat. Carrol is a member of the Trials Methodology Research Partnership Statistical Analysis and Health Informatics Working Groups and co-chairs the Data Sharing sub group.

Carrol chaired the UK network of statisticians in UKCRC registered Clinical Trials Units for 10 years, was a member of the UKCRC registered CTU group

on data sharing and is now deputy Chair for the Policy Group.
